The toilets and the crèche (for kids under three) can be reached through the door to the left of the stage.

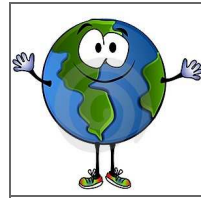
The Quiet Room, on the left hand side of the auditorium, is for parents who would like to listen to the message while they are feeding their babies.
